
## Sights @ Work



**Brazil:** AquaRio, Rio de Janeiro's first aquarium, partnered with UNIC Rio de Janeiro to promote the Ocean Conference. Educational materials prepared jointly were distributed to visitors.



**Italy:** The Leaning Tower and the Field of Miracles in Pisa. The Field of Miracles is one of the most famous places in the world, hosting the Leaning Tower, the Duomo, the Baptistery, Monumental Cemetery and Museums. Located right at the edge of the old medieval town, its construction started in the XI century.

Not only does the United Nations Information Centre (UNIC) Windhoek educate the Namibian public about the work of the UN and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through outreach and digital campaigns, but now the Centre will also raise awareness of the colorful Goals while driving, as its new vehicle has been branded with the SDGs.

#### **UNIC Vehicle Promotes the SDGs**

at a handover ceremony this month, is also branded with the local character called "Frieda" who teaches young and old about the SDGs. The branding intends to carry the message of the SDGs wherever UNIC Windhoek travels in carrying out its work.

The SDGs, is a set of 17 Global Goals with 169 indicators. The 193 Member States of the United Nations lead the efforts to achieve these Goals, partnering and calling to action the private sector and civil society. These inclusive collaborations are based upon shared, principles, values and visions that place people and the planet at the centre, and are needed at the global, regional, national and local level.



The vehicle donation comes at a critical time, since the Centre has not been mobile for over five

years, relying on outsourced companies in the execution of daily operational activities as well as educational outreach initiatives aimed toward bolstering the message of the UN System in Namibia.




The donated car will aid the Centre with its capability and responsiveness in meeting its mandate to promote greater public understanding of and support for the aims and activities of the UN. This is done by disseminating primarily information on the work of the Organization to the Namibian people, especially in remote areas. The donation is in line with inter-agency collaborative efforts in promoting the work of the United Nations within Namibia.

#### Australia



#### Turn the Tide against Plastics

In Adelaide, Australia, a call to *Turn the Tide against Plastics* was answered by the citizens of Adelaide by dressing in black suits and top hats and forming a solemn line at the ocean's edge staring out on an ocean in serious trouble. They were participating in a performance piece by artist Andrew Baines. Amongst the participants were the UNIC Canberra Director, the Mayor of Port Adelaide and the Lord Mayor of the City of Adelaide, all of whom spoke before the event and then joined the line at the water's edge in solidarity, 28 May.

#### Austria



#### **Celebrating Chinese Language Day**

On the occasion of UN Chinese Language Day, the UN in Vienna underscored the importance of multilingualism in paying tribute to Chinese art and culture. The Chinese Permanent Mission to the United Nations in Vienna, in cooperation with UNIS Vienna and other partners, hosted a celebration in the Rotunda of the Vienna International Centre. The event featured music, performances, and a display of Dunhang frescoes and paintings, 8 May.



Ciné-ONU Vienna Film Screening of *Tickling Giants* 

To mark World Press Freedom Day, UNIS Vienna's monthly film series Ciné-ONU screened the documentary 'Tickling Giants. The film is about the first political satire show in Egypt and its creator Dr Bassem Youssef who tests the limits of free press. The ensuing panel featured representatives from the International Press Institute and OSCE Representative on Freedom of the Media. It was moderated by UNIS Vienna, 8 May.



Japanese Foreign Minister Visits Guided Tours Exhibit

In Vienna for the Preparatory Committee session for the 2020 Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, Japanese Foreign Minister Fumio Kishida paid a visit to the Visitors Service exhibition *Towards a World Free of Nuclear Weapons*, which was installed in 2014 in partnership with the Permanent Mission of Japan and the Cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, 2 May.



#### Bahrain



#### UNIC Director's Participation at Bahrain for All Kids Fun Day Event

For the second consecutive year, the Director of UNIC Manama participated and interacted with children with special needs at a Kids Fun Day Out event organized by Bahrain for All aimed at raising awareness on the importance of actively engaging with differently-abled individuals. #### Bangladesh

#### Brazil



#### Lecture for Students at the Brazilian Conservatory of Music

UNIC Rio officials explained the mechanisms and structure of human rights of the UN System, with the UNIC Director explaining related aspects of international diplomacy and his experience in the field in several missions, 22 May.

The UNIC Rio de Janeiro Director spoke at the opening ceremony and participated in the first day of the event. #### Belgium



Visibility for the UN Liaison Office for Peace

In the prelude to the 44<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Meeting, experts from Angola, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Democratic Republic of Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Rwanda, and Sao Tome and Principe, met under the chairmanship of Cameroon's Ambassador to the UN, to assess the security and geopolitical situation in their countries. Visit of the Security Council to Colombia




